

#### Facebook features


People who use facebook are over 13 years old.






Enter your name, surname, email and password to log in

to your facebook account.




Select your date of birth, gender and click on Sign up.




You will receive an email confirming

that your account has been created.




Log back in to the facebook page and enter your username and password you have chosen.

2. Write the name of the person you are looking for and click on the search button.




3. To send a friend request, click on the "Add friend" button next to the profile picture.

## How to add or join a group?

3. Click on the button "Join" next to the profile picture of the group you are interested in.

The steps to send a message in Facebook chat from a computer are as follows.

#### Step 1.



Click on the chat icon

and click on New Message.

#### Step 2.

Search the name of the person you want to write.

#### Step 3.

Select from the name list the person or friends

to send the message.


#### Step 4.

Write your message

and click "Enter" to send it.

You can also send a message by going to the person's profile and clicking on the Message button.

## How to use your homepage?



Your homepage is the page that appears when you log in to Facebook.

The home page displays updated posts from your friends, groups and pages of interest.

You can react to each post by liking, sharing or commenting on it.


# How to like publications and interact on Facebook?



Clicking "Like" on a Facebook post means that we like it.

Everyone who sees that post can also see that you like it.

# How to like publications and interact on Facebook?



For example, when you "Like" a video, people

who can see it will know that you like it.

And the person who posted it receives

a notification that you have liked it.



Twitter is another platform


where people can communicate with short messages.

These messages are called tweets.

This platform allows you to tweet.

Tweeting is posting short messages to anyone

who follows you on Twitter.




You can also use Twitter to find out about interesting people and companies by following the tweets they post.



This social network provides quick updates from friends, family, journalists and experts.

Twitter allows people to describe and share everyday things.




To create a new Twitter account,


You can sign up for twitter from a gmail account, an apple account or your mobile phone number.



When using a gmail account, enter your email address and password.




When using apple account, enter your information apple account and password.



You chose your phone number to create a new account, enter your first and last name, mobile phone number and date of birth.


## Twitter features



Once you have your account, you can start tweeting.

To tweet click on the Tweet button on your screen.

### Twitter features



Compose the Tweet.

In each tweet you can write a total of 280 characters.

The **characters** are letters, symbols or numbers.

When you write a tweet include a #hashtag

so that other people can follow your account.

For example, a hashtag is #elections.

### Twitter features



You can also tag a person

by using the symbol @

and then the person's name on Twitter.

Tagging is putting the name of the person you want to name in the tweet.

#### **Twitter**

You can also follow other people, organizations on Twitter to find out what other people think.

To follow other people, click on the search icon in the main Twitter menu.

Type the name of the person to follow and click on that person's name in the list of search results

to enter the person's profile.

When you enter the person's profile or organisation clicks on the Follow button.

#### Zoom




Zoom is a video platform that allows you to hold online meetings, seminars and events.

You can create a Zoom account or join a meeting by clicking on the link sent to you. The person organising the meeting or event

creates the link and sends it to all interested people.

Zoom is available for computers, tablets and mobile phones.

## Installing Zoom




The installation of Zoom on a computer is done automatically when you click on the meeting link.

Installation on a tablet or mobile phone is not mandatory,

but it is more practical to use it.

## Installing Zoom



After downloading the application click on Open Zoom meeting.

## Installing Zoom



To install Zoom on a tablet or mobile phone, go to the app shop and search for Zoom.


## Joining a Zoom Meeting

The easier way to connect to a Zoom meeting is through a link.

In the image you can see an example of an invitation to join a meeting.



## Joining a Zoom Meeting



From the downloaded app

you can also connect to a meeting.

To connect you will need the meeting code

and password.


This information is also sent

by the person hosting the meeting.



In this image you can see how the zoom menu appears on a mobile phone.

In this image you can see how the zoom menu appears on a computer or tablet.





The Mute icon turns the microphone on and off.

When you are not talking, it is best to keep it off.



By clicking on this icon you can turn the camera on or off.

When the camera is turned off, your profile picture is displayed

or a blank box with your name.




By clicking on this icon you can see all the people who are currently in the meeting and you can also invite others.



Click on this icon to access the chat

and write to other people participating in the meeting.

You can write to one person or to everyone.



To leave the meeting,


click on this icon.

# Tips when participating on a Zoom meeting

- Look at the camera when you speak.
- Keep the camera at eye level.
- Turn off the microphone when you are not speaking.
- Good face light.
- Be patient when there are technical problems.
- Greet and say goodbye when participating in a meeting.
